This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act request of October 7, 1986, for information on the Interplanetary Phenomenon Unit of the Scientific and Technical Branch, Counterintelligence Directorate, Department of the Army. Your request was received in this office on 15 October 1986.

Please excuse the delay in responding to your request, but due to an extraordinary administrative and operational burden placed on this office by a shortage of personnel, a considerable backlog of requests has accumulated.

Please be advised that the aforementioned Army unit was disestablished during the late 1950's and never reactivated. All records pertaining to this unit were turned over to the US Air Force, Office of Special Investigations in conjunction with operation "BLUEBOOK."
